Individuals nominated must have taught for at least three years and have provided exceptional (outstanding) service to the FFA chapter, agricultural industry, and agricultural education. Individuals nominated from a chapter must have the approval of the State FFA Executive Secretary. Nominations may also be made by members of the State Board of Directors, State FFA Officers, and state staff of the Florida FFA Association and Florida FFA Foundation.

All nominations must be submitted on this official nomination form postmarked on or before May 1.
